Awards will be made in the categories listed here. The individual examples below are meant to suggest types of people who could be included in the category. These examples do not attempt to be all-inclusive. Please use the individual listings as a catalyst for your own imagination.

Applied Technology/ Science/Research: architects, engineers, information technologists, computer analysts, chemists, research scientists, biologists, research and development specialists

Arts/Entertainment: interior designers, sculptors, painters, writers, graphic designers, dancers, photographers, singers, musicians, athletes, entertainment establishment employees

Community Service/Community Advocate: philanthropists, board members, volunteers, advocates

Consulting/Training/Education: business trainers, teachers, business consultants, public speakers, superintendents, principals, school board members, professors

Entrepreneurship: business owners both public and private

Finance/Banking: accountants, CPAs, stockbrokers, financial planners, banking officers, banking managers, CFOs, bank tellers, portfolio managers, actuaries

Healthcare: psychiatrists, psychologists, family therapists, therapists, physical therapists, doctors, nurses, occupational therapists, exercise physiologists, sports medicine professionals, hospital employees, health club employees, veterinarians

Judicial: attorneys, paralegals, judges

Law/Law Enforcement: probation officers, police officers, and citizen volunteers

Management: CEOs, department heads private and public, any type of leadership position

Manufacturing: supervisors or any employees involved in producing a product for resale

Media/Communications: television, radio and print writers, producers, on air personalities, public relations professionals, telecommunications employees, reporters

Ministry: pastors, religious educators and activists, scholars, lay leaders in faith-based communities, theologians

Office Support: bookkeepers, clerks, administrative assistants, secretaries, receptionists, data entry clerks, TPA, billing services representatives

Public Service/Government: public service agency employees, utility company employees, directors in local, county, state and federal agencies

Sales/Marketing: sales representatives, marketing managers, telemarketers, realtors, insurance agents

Service Industry: retailers, caterers, florists, cleaning service providers, event planners, restaurant employees, dry cleaners, transportation providers, printers, hotels/motel employees, travel agents, employment agency representatives, grocers, pet groomers, tailors, hair stylists, cosmetologists, other beauty industry representatives

Skilled Trades: plumbers, electricians, welders, carpenters, construction, builders, landscapers

Sports: coaches, athletes, sports trainers
